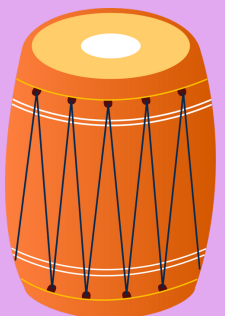
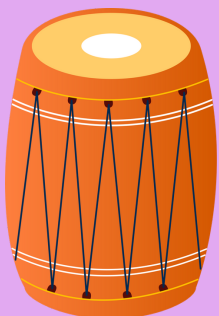
○○○ Welcome Back to School

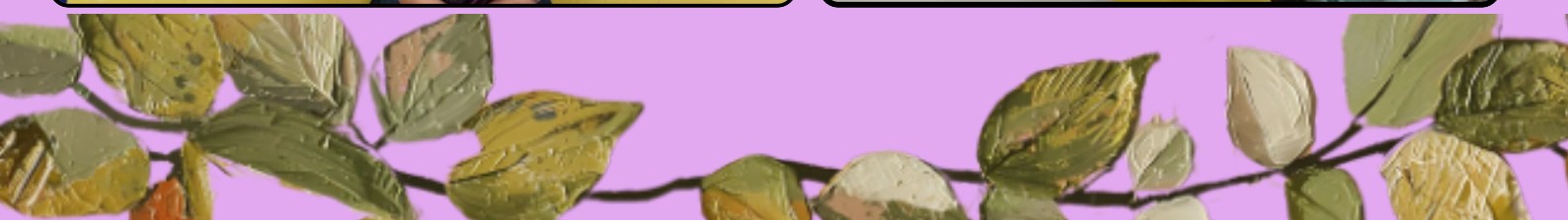
BAISAUKHI CELEBRATION

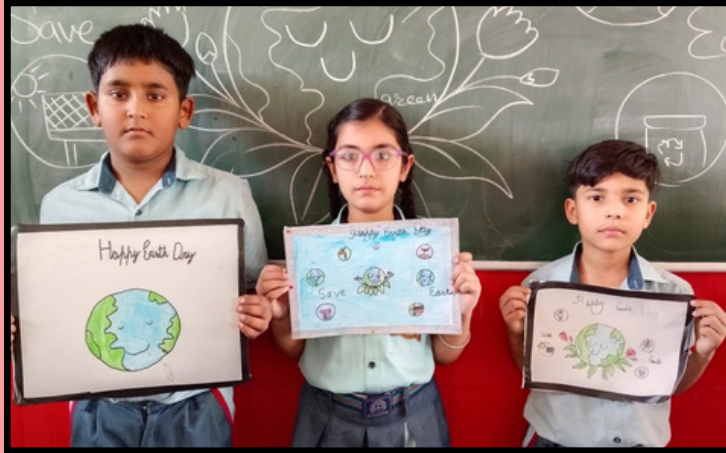
ORIENTATION PROGRAM

The school organized a joyful Splash Party for students with fun water-based activities. Children enjoyed boat floating, where they placed paper boats in water and observed them float.



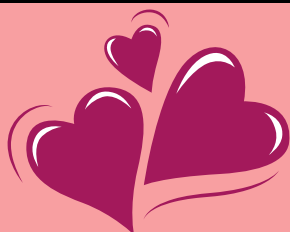
HINDI POEM RECITATION COMPETITION

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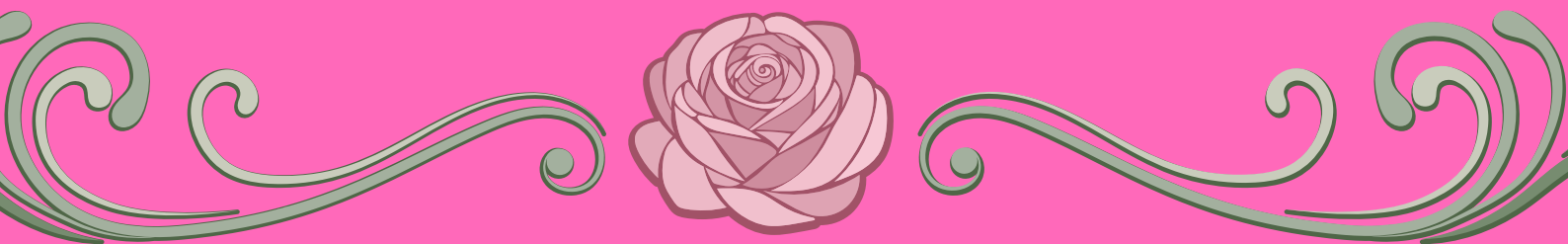
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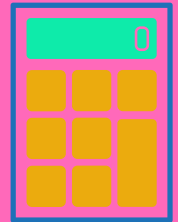
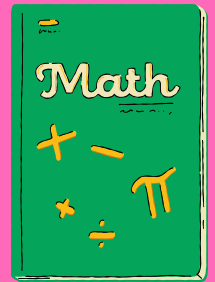

EXCURSION TO RANGLA PUNJAB

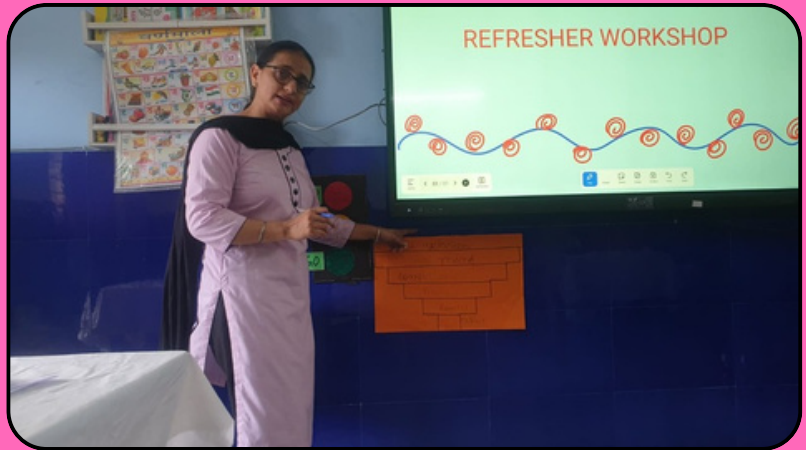
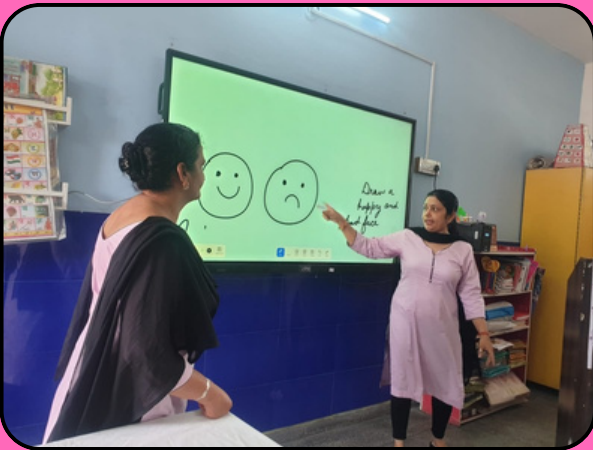

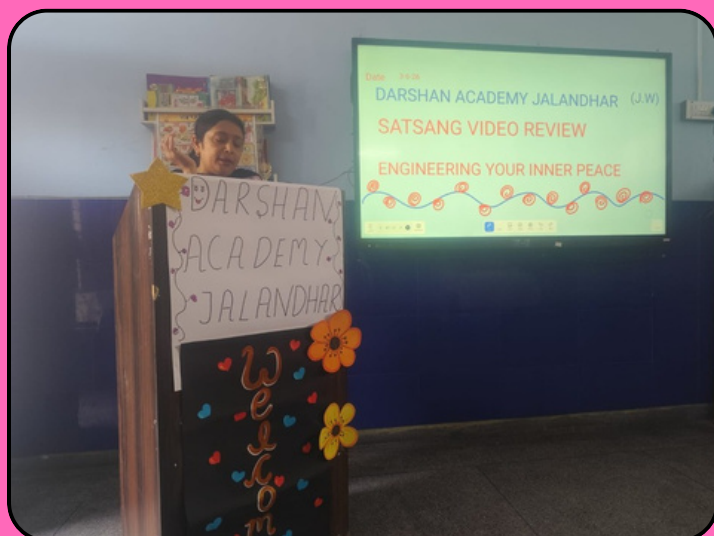
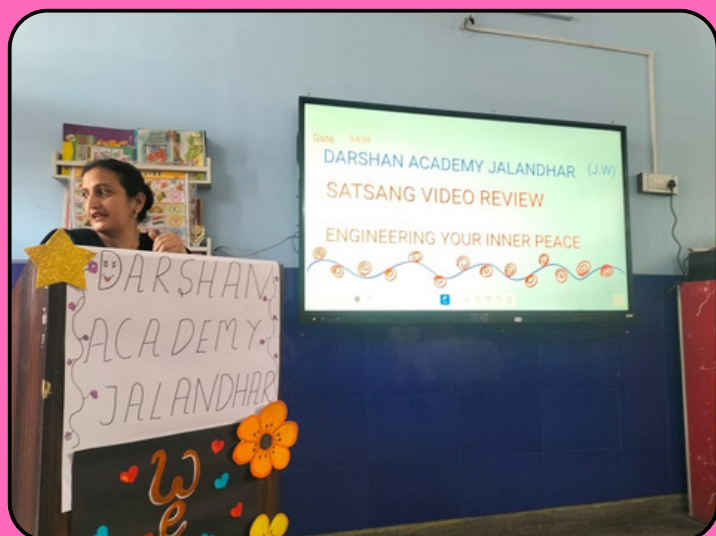
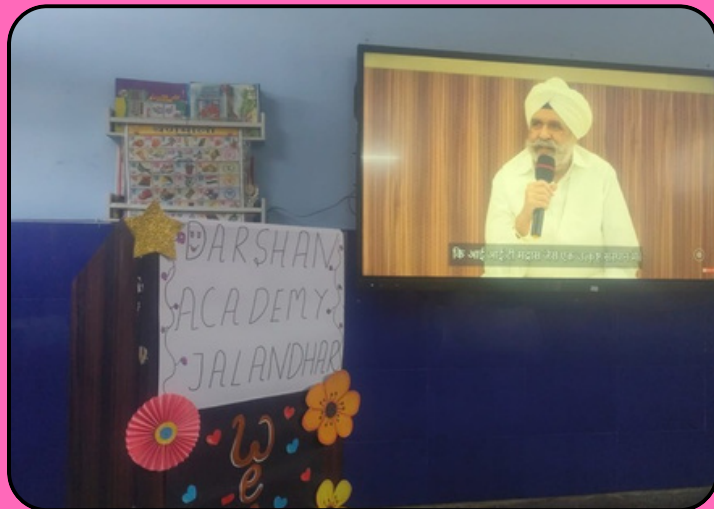
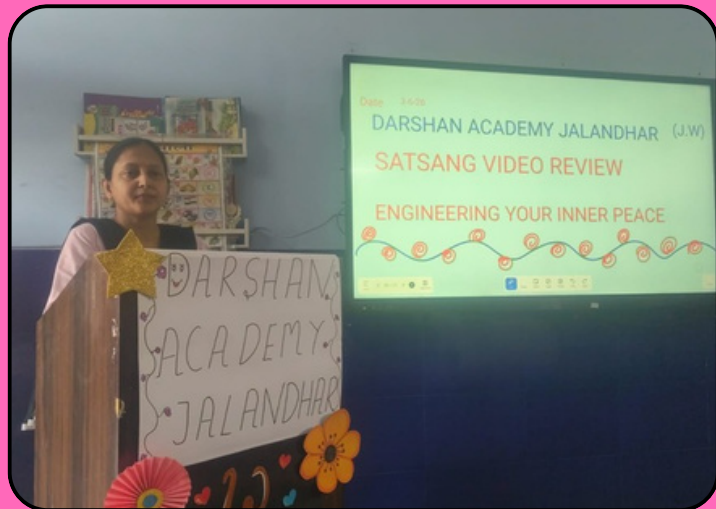
REFRESHER WORKSHOP

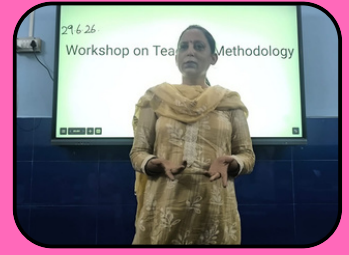
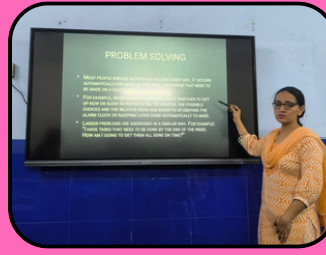
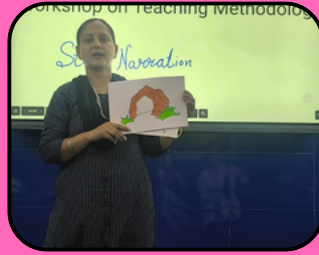
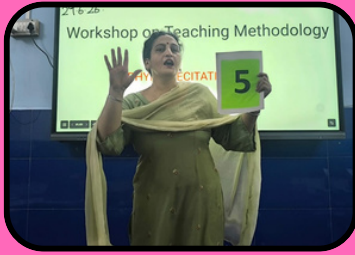
SATSANG REVIEW WORKSHOP

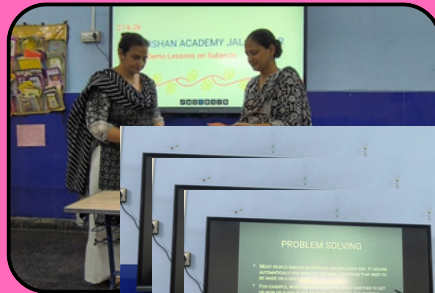
TEACHING METHODOLOGY

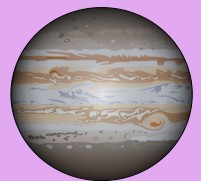
